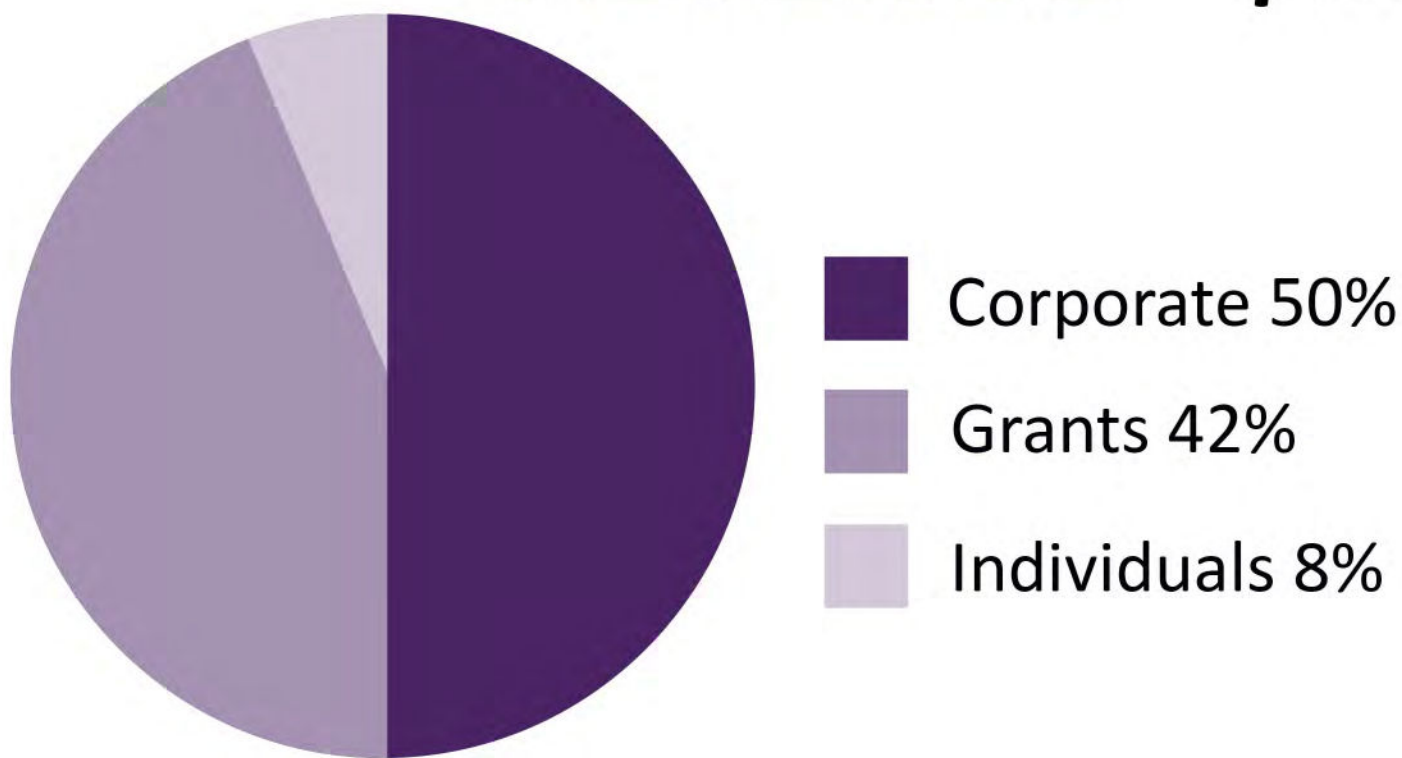

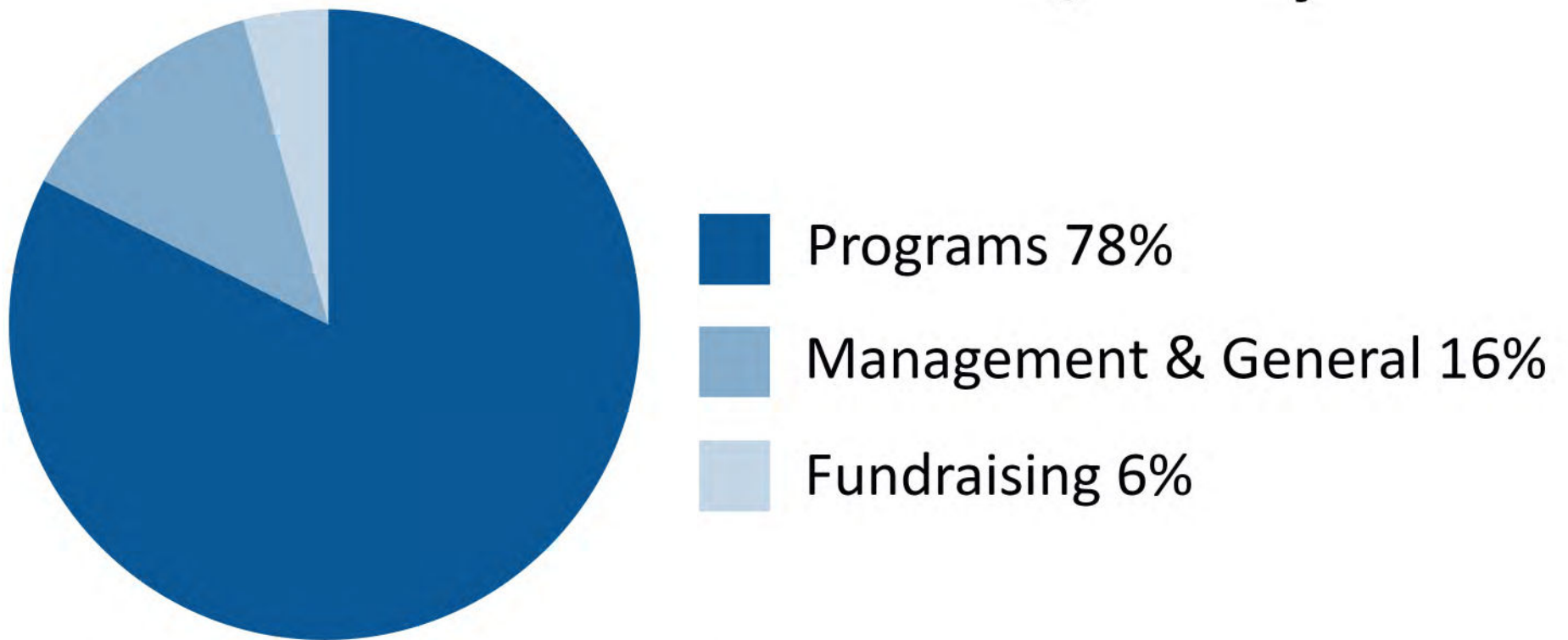

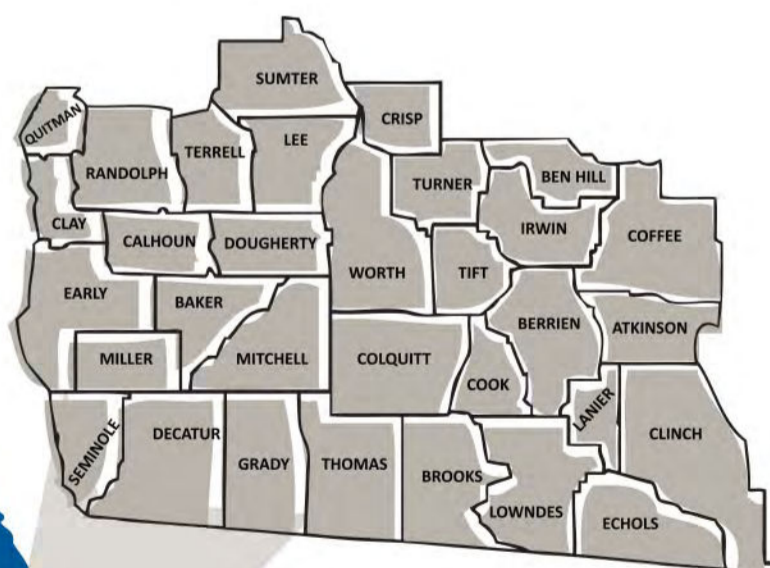

DANIEL B. JONES • Radiation treatments are every day, often for months. For Daniel B. Jones, a local cancer patient, it is exhausting and what makes it even worse is worrying about the cost of gas to get to the cancer center day after day. But Mr. Jones was referred to the Cancer Coalition, and we are now able to provide him with weekly

gasoline gift cards through our Patient Assistance Program. “I thank God for the Cancer Coalition,” he says, “Because of your program, it’s possible for me to make it to my treatments. Without your organization, I would be in real trouble.”

JUNE CHILDERS • June Childers needed to have a colonoscopy. After telling her doctor that she didn’t have any health insurance, he mentioned the Cancer Coalition and she is forever grateful that he did. Our staff member Beverly Nembhard served as Ms. Childers’ Health Navigator. Ms. Childers was scared, but Beverly was with her through the entire process. “My navigator, Beverly, was an angel,” Ms. Childers explained. “She talked me through it and calmed my nerves so I wasn’t worried about the test anymore.” With our help, Ms. Childers was able to receive the care she needed, which led to a cancerous tumor being removed. She now tells everyone to get screened because it may save their life.

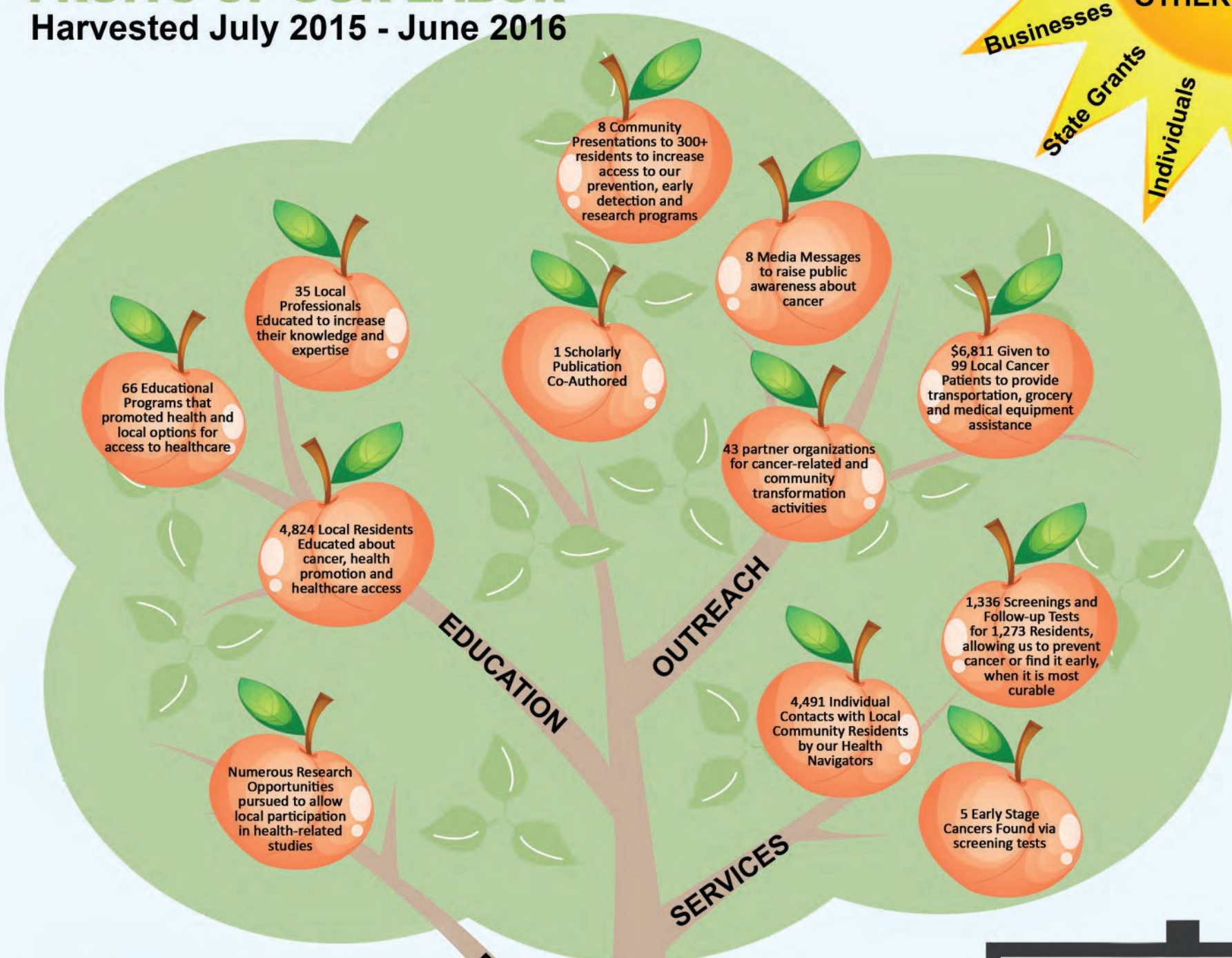

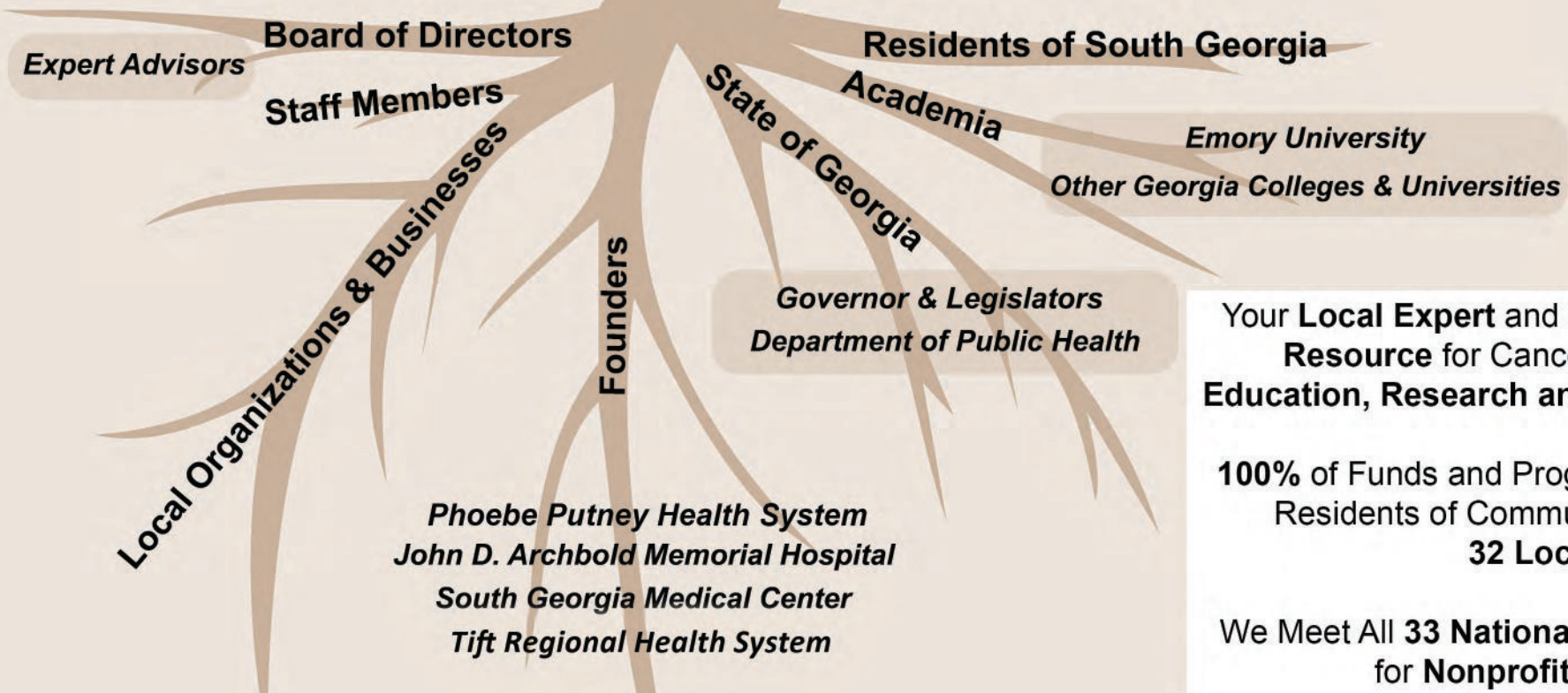
